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The City of Brooks' Works and Utility Services Department has an immediate opening for a Utility Operator. This is an entry level position, developing the skills, knowledge and qualifications to become a certified Level 1 Utility Operator. Employees in this classification will normally work under supervision but may work independently as assigned.

The successful applicant must have completed the twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) school grade, or equivalent, and must possess a Class 5 Operator's License. The applicant must have the capability to progress toward the completion of the Water and Waste Water Operator's Certificate program, and must also be able to complete basic safety training. The applicant must have the ability to understand the chemical and mechanical processes involved in water and waste water treatment, and must have the ability to operate computer systems related to water and waste water operations. Preferred applicants will possess municipal experience in the operation of water and waste water facilities and associated functions. Equivalencies may be considered. Applicants must be bondable.
