

**CITY OF BROOKS
BYLAW NO. 23/07**

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO SET A RATE FOR THE BUSINESS TAX LEVY ON BUSINESSES LOCATED IN THE BROOKS TOWN CENTRE REVITALIZATION ZONE.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brooks has, by Bylaw, established a business revitalization zone and business tax for members of that zone;

AND WHEREAS the expenditures of the Brooks Town Centre Revitalization Zone Association have been estimated and approved at \$15,000.00 for the period January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023; and,

AND WHEREAS the total business assessment in the Brooks Town Centre Revitalization Zone has been computed at \$175,000.

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Brooks in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

There shall be imposed upon all businesses on the Business Assessment Roll of the City of Brooks a levy of 85.71 mills on the assessment.

The Municipal Secretary of the City of Brooks shall enter upon the Business Tax Roll of the City of Brooks in a column provided for that purpose, the amount of which the property is chargeable.

Read a first time this 20th day of March, 2023.

Read a second time this 17th day of April, 2023.

Read a third time and finally passed this 17th day of April, 2023.
