CITY OF BROOKS BYLAW NO. 24/07

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW 22/04 BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION AND PARKS BOARD.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to amend Bylaw 22/04 being the Recreation and Parks Board Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Brooks in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Subsection 306 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

306. Not more than one (1) youth citizen-at-large position of either the City of Brooks or County of Newell appointed by the Council of the applicable municipality, between the ages of fourteen (14) and eighteen (18).
2. That the following Subsection be added to the Bylaw:

506. Motions do not require a seconder and can be moved and presented by a single member. Motions shall only be carried upon receiving a majority of votes.
3. That the aforementioned amendments to Bylaw No. 22/04, being the Recreation and Parks Board Bylaw, make use of formatting that maintains the consistency of the portions of the Bylaw being amended.
4. That this Bylaw take effect upon final passing thereof.
