



CITY OF BROOKS BYLAW NO. 25/17

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BYLAW 23/05 BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH RATES TO BE CHARGED IN RELATION TO FIRE PREVENTION, INSPECTION, SUPPRESSION AND RESCUE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to amend Bylaw 23/05 being the Fire Service Fees Bylaw;


NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Brooks in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" of Bylaw No. 23/05 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Schedule "A".
2. That Bylaw 24/15 be hereby repealed.
3. That this Bylaw take effect upon final passing thereof.

Read a second time this 5th day of May, 2025.

Read a third time and finally passed this 5th day of May, 2025.

SCHEDULE "A"
Bylaw No. 25/17

1. Inspection Services
 - a) Charge out rate for licensed premises occupancy load inspection and certification:
 - (i) \$75.00 per inspection
 - b) Inspection and report on buildings where Fire Code inspection is requested by bank, mortgage company or other financial institution:
 - (i) \$75.00 per hour
 - c) Document search relative to environmental condition reports:
 - (i) \$75.00 per hour
 - d) Inspection of buildings according to Fire Services Quality Management Plan:
 - (i) Initial inspection: \$25.00 for all occupancies listed in the Fire Department's Quality Management Plan;
 - (ii) Initial inspection: \$25.00 when requested by the building owner/lessee; and,
 - (iii) All properties requiring a second or subsequent inspection will be charged a fee of \$75.00 per hour or part thereof.
2. Fire Suppression charges for vehicle fires to all persons who reside outside the Province of Alberta or response to motor vehicle/trailer/other equipment fires on major highways.

3. Fire response to railway land:
 - a) Engines/Pumpers and/or Rescue Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - b) Bush Buggies/Rapid Response Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - c) Tenders/Mobile Water Supply Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - d) Command Units \$215/Unit/Hour* (Includes equipment costs, labour and materials)
4. Response to vehicle accidents/collisions where a Fire Department vehicle(s) is/are required to respond:
 - a) Engines/Pumpers and/or Rescue Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - b) Bush Buggies/Rapid Response Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - c) Tenders/Mobile Water Supply Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - d) Command Units \$215/Unit/Hour* (Includes equipment costs, labour and materials)
5. Hydrant flow tests required by Developer/Builder:
 - a) \$200.00 per test
6. False Alarm Responses:
 - a) 1st incident - written request to remedy condition causing the false alarm
 - b) 2nd and every subsequent incident with same circumstances - \$200.00 response fee
7. Standby charge at dangerous goods incident:
 - a) Engines/Pumpers and/or Rescue Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - b) Bush Buggies/Rapid Response Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - c) Tenders/Mobile Water Supply Units \$740/Unit/Hour*
 - d) Command Units \$215/Unit/Hour* (Includes equipment costs, labour and materials)
8. Fire Investigations other than for fire reporting:
 - a) \$75.00 per hour
9. Permits to Burn:
 - a) \$20.00 per permit
10. Fire Pit Permits
 - a) \$30.00 per permit

11. Inspections and reports prepared in response to the receipt of a complaint:
 - a) The initial inspection plus one follow-up inspection shall be provided without charge. All time expended following the initial and follow-up inspections shall be billed at \$75.00 per hour.
12. Any other inspection or service not specifically enumerated in this Schedule "A" shall be billed at \$75.00 per hour.
