



**CITY OF BROOKS  
BYLAW NO. 26/011**

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO  
AMEND BYLAW 26/008 BEING A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE  
PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL AND COMMITTEE MEETINGS.**

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable to amend Bylaw 26/008 being the Procedural Bylaw;

**NOW, THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Brooks in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the following Subsections be added to the Bylaw:

317. Every person present at a Council or Council Committee meeting shall remove any head covering upon entering and shall remain without such head covering while in attendance.

318. Notwithstanding Subsection 317, the requirement does not apply to:

319. religious head coverings worn as part of religious beliefs;

320. medical or accessibility-related head coverings required for health, safety, or accommodation needs; or,

321. official uniforms worn by law enforcement, emergency services, or military personnel while acting in an official capacity.

322. Electronic and cellular devices shall be set on silent and no person shall talk on a cell phone while in attendance at a Council or Council Committee meeting.

2. That this Bylaw take effect upon final passing thereof.

Read a second time this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2026.

Read a third time and finally passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2026.
